The following is a list of actions Cottage City residents must adhere to during snow and ice weather events:

- * Plowed or shoveled snow shall not be cast into street.
- * During clean up cars should be moved so that crews can plow snow up against the curb to insure the max amount of parking is available.
- * Residents are responsible to clean sidewalks adjacent to their property within 24 hours of the end of the snow event.
- * No running water is permitted to flow into street or sidewalks.
- * Park off street if possible.

COLD WEATHER SAFETY TIPS

As temperatures drop this winter, the American Red Cross offers ten steps people can take to stay safe during the cold weather.

1. **Layer up!** Wear layers of lightweight clothing to stay warm. Gloves and a hat will help prevent losing your body heat.
2. **Don't forget your furry friends.** Bring pets indoors.
3. **Remember the three feet rule.** If you are using a space heater, place it on a level and keep anything flammable at least three feet away. Remember to turn them off or unplug.
4. **Don't catch fire!** If you are using a fireplace, use a glass or metal fire screen large enough to catch sparks and rolling logs.
5. **Protect your pipes.** Prevent your pipes from freezing. Open the kitchen and bathroom cabinet doors to allow warmer air to circulate around the plumbing.
6. **Use generators outside.** Never operate a generator inside the home, including in the basement or garage and don't hook a generator up to the home's wiring.

CONSEJOS PARA EL TIEMPO FRÍO

4. **¡No cause incendios!** Si está usando una chimenea, utilice una pantalla de fuego de vidrio o metal lo suficientemente grande como para atrapar chispas y rollos de madera.
5. **Proteja sus tuberías.** Evite que las tuberías se congelen. Abra la cocina y las puertas del gabinete del baño para permitir que el aire más caliente circule alrededor de la fontanería.
6. **Utilice generadores fuera.** Nunca opere un generador dentro de la casa, incluyendo en el sótano o garaje y no conecte el generador a los circuitos de la casa.

**CODE ENFORCEMENT:
GARBAGE AND TRASH COLLECTION**

Section 3-2. Garbage Containers.

It is hereby ordained and required that within the corporate limits of the Town of Cottage City all garbage and any refuse consisting of waste animals or vegetable matter upon which insects and rats may feed, or in which insects may breed, and all small dead animals, shall be placed and stored until collected, in rust resistant, tight, non-absorbent, and easily washable receptacles which are covered with close fitting lids. These receptacles must be of adequate capacity (10 or 20 gallon), and must be provided in sufficient number to hold all collectible garbage and refuse that accumulates between collections. All cans shall be washed occasionally, and treated with disinfectant, if necessary, to prevent odors from being a nuisance.

Section 3-3. Storage of Rubbish.

All rubbish shall be stored in covered containers between collections except in the case of large articles, such as logs. Such large articles should be cut into sections not to exceed three feet in length and placed at the street curb for collection. All trash must be bagged and put in a container. **If you have trash that is not in a trash can, you will be subject to a fine from Code Enforcement in the amount of \$100.00.**

Sección 3-2. Los contenedores de basura.

Por la presente se ordena y exige que dentro de los límites corporativos de Cottage City toda la basura y cualquier basura consistente en desecho de animales o materia vegetal donde insectos y ratas pueden alimentarse, o los insectos Puedan reproducirse, y todos los pequeños animales muertos, colocados y almacenados en recipientes resistentes a la roya, apretados, no absorbente, lavable y que fácilmente se cubran con tapas bien cerradas. Estos recipientes deben tener una capacidad adecuada (10 o 20 galones), y deben ser proporcionados en número suficiente para contener toda la basura y desperdicios de colección que se acumula. Todos los recipientes de basura se deben lavar de vez en cuando, y se trataran con desinfectante, si es necesario, para evitar los olores de prevención de ser una molestia.

Sección 3-3. El almacenamiento de los desperdicios.

Todas las basuras deberán almacenarse en recipientes cubiertos Entre las colecciones, excepto en el caso de artículos anchos, como los troncos. Tales secciones amplias deberían ser cortado en secciones que no exceda de tres pies de largo y se colocan en la cera de la calle para su recogida. Toda la basura debe colocarse en bolsas y se pone en un recipiente. **Si usted tiene basura que no está en un bote de basura, usted estará sujeto a una multa de Aplicación del Código en la cantidad de \$100.**

The Port Towns EcoDistrict Stormwater Masterplan Project is the first official project of the Port Towns EcoDistrict.

The goal of the Port Towns EcoDistrict Stormwater Masterplan Project is to prepare a stormwater master plan/study identifying sites with stormwater problems within the Port Towns of Bladensburg, Colmar Manor, Cottage City, and Edmonston. This is the first step to develop an integrated stormwater strategy that will minimize the impact of stormwater runoff, impervious surfaces and flooding; maximize non-potable water use; integrate stormwater management and green infrastructure practices into projects and increase the health and well-being of local residents within the Port Towns
